

WINTER RV DRIVING SAFETY CHECKLIST

Before You Start the Engine

Check tire pressures on both tow vehicle and RV. Clear all snow and ice from the roof, slide toppers, mirrors, headlights, and cameras. Warm the windshield with defroster to prevent fogging. Turn on tank heaters in severe cold. Enable Tow/Haul mode and turn cruise control off.

While You're on the Road

Match your speed to visibility and traction. Watch the pavement for shiny ice, drifting snow, or fading lane lines. Use smooth steering and low-beam headlights in snow or fog. Check mirrors frequently for trailer sway and slow early when traction feels limited.

When You Arrive

Enter snowy campsites slowly. Walk the area to find hidden ice or soft ground. Keep your engine running briefly to stabilize temps. Activate tank heaters and freeze protection. Use a heated water hose in freezing conditions and avoid using awnings or slide toppers.
